Article II.5 Provisions (Teacher's Master Contract)

- B. Credit for Prior Teaching, Military, Governmental, and/or Employmenet Experience
- 2. Teachers will receive credit on the Placement Salary Schedule for active military service, up to a maximum of ten (10) years. To receive a year of credit, at least ten (10) months of service must have been rendered as verfied by proper military authorities.
 - C. Placement for Retired Educators
- 1. Educators who retired from Escambia County District Schools and who return to full time employment in Escambia County shall receive ten (10) years of experience credit for placement purposes.
- 2. Educators who retired or who will be eiligible for retirement from any other school district during their first year of employment with the Escambia County District Schools shall receive ten (10) years of experience credit for placement purposes.
